

The Graduate School, Kasetsart University, Announcement of Graduate Scholarship for International Students Under the Double or Joint Degree Programs

The Graduate School, Kasetsart University, is to allocate graduate scholarships for international students under the Double or Joint Degree Programs, in order to support the publication of students' theses in international journals, and to help graduate students to acquire research experience. A portion of the funding for the scholarship, ten million Baht, is drawn from a governmental budget via the Kasetsart University Research and Development Institute (KURDI), as of fiscal year 2017, and five million Baht is provided from the income budget of Kasetsart University. It is open to lecturers and international master's and doctoral degree students as follows:

1. Qualifications of Applicants

- 1.1 Graduate lecturers must be permanent lecturers who are eligible to be thesis advisors, and must have publications in international journals during the last five (5) years which were not work written in order to complete a lecturer's graduation. Lecturers who are above 58 but not over 60 years of age (as of 1 October 2017), must receive consent from their Head of Department allowing that selected lecturers can use facilities and equipment until their international students graduate. Each lecturer is eligible to apply for only one (1) scholarship per fiscal year.
- 1.2 International students who are approved to study under the Double or Joint Degree Programs and enrolled at Kasetsart University in Fiscal Year 2017.

2. Scholarship Allocations

Selected students are eligible to obtain a tuition fee waiver from their study program, together with a monthly allowance at the rate specified below:

- 2.1 Master's degree students: 8,000 Baht per month, throughout their study period at Kasetsart University but not in excess of two (2) years.
- 2.2 Doctoral degree students: 10,000 Baht per month, throughout their study period at Kasetsart University but not in excess of three (3) years.

3. Scholarship Terms and Conditions/ Scholarship Extension

- 3.1 Each thesis advisor is eligible to receive only one (1) scholarship per fiscal year.
- 3.2 The scholarship receiver shall assist his/her student to graduate according to the graduation criteria specified in the Double or Joint Degree Program in which the student is enrolls.
- 3.3 The Graduate School shall suspend monthly scholarship provision during the period that student does not stay in Thailand for longer than 30 days.

3.4 Students must submit study and research progress reports with approval from their thesis advisor, in order to extend the scholarship into the following year. If students fail to do so, The Graduate School is permitted to end the scholarship extension, and students cannot re-apply for this scholarship.

3.5 Students must write in their Acknowledgement Page that their research is supported by The Graduate School, Kasetsart University.

Lecturers and students who want to apply for the scholarship must complete application forms (downloaded from www.grad.ku.ac.th) and submit them with pertinent documents to the Scholarship Unit, Educational Services Section, 3rd floor, The Graduate School building, from now until Monday, August 21, 2017. The Graduate School will not consider any overdue application forms. The decision made by The Board of The Graduate School is final.
