



**The Graduate School, Kasetsart University Announcement on  
Thesis Proposal Submission, Tuition Fee Payment, and Student Restoration for  
Doctoral Degree Students Enrolled since the First Semester of 2016 Academic Year and  
Master's Degree Students Enrolled since the First Semester of 2017 Academic Year**

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In order to conform to the Academic Regulations of Graduate Studies, Kasetsart University, B.E. 2559 (2016), Item 26 specifying that doctoral degree students are required to submit thesis proposal with the consent of thesis advisor, and Head of Department or Graduate Program Committee Chairperson in the students' major fields of study before the end of the 6<sup>th</sup> regular semester since commencement of studies, and master's degree students are required to submit thesis proposal with the consent of the thesis advisor, and the Head of Department or the Graduate Program Committee Chairperson in the students' major fields of study before the end of the 4<sup>th</sup> regular semester since commencement of studies. **Doctoral degree students enrolled since the first semester of 2016 academic year and master's degree students enrolled since the first semester of 2017 academic year must submit their thesis proposals by Monday 13 May 2019.** Failure to do so results in the termination of student status as specified in the Academic Regulations B.E. 2559 (2016), item 32(7).

In case that students pay tuition fee for registration in the first semester of academic year 2019, students are required to submit their thesis proposals within a time frame specified in paragraph 1. Otherwise, the registration will be void.

Students whose statuses are terminated owing to the failure of thesis proposals submission within the timeframe specified are able to submit a request for their student status restoration. The restoration is subject to consent from students' thesis advisor and Head of Department, or Graduate Program Committee Chairperson. The Dean of The Graduate School is to consider approval of the restoration request, and is able to set up applicable conditions for the continuance of student status as specified in the Academic Regulations B.E. 2559 (2016), item 33. The last days of student status restoration of Thai and international curriculum are presented as follows:

	Thai Curriculum	International Curriculum
The last days of student status restoration	Friday 12 July 2019	Friday 9 August 2019

These documents are required for student status restoration submission:

1. A General Request Form (GS 01) with a reason to restore students' status
2. Thesis proposal with GS04 and GS05 forms or thesis proposal via iThesis with GS 05-2
3. A copy of approved thesis advisory committee appointment (approved GS02) or an Appointment/Change of Student's Advisory Committee Request Form (GS02) in case that students do not request for thesis advisory committee appointment

After receiving an approval for student's status restoration, students are required to register in order to complete the restoration process.
