Publication

Thesis / Independent Study is published as specified in the terms and conditions of the study field/program.

4

Final Oral Examination

All coursework requirements are completed as specified in the curriculum. Thesis proposal has been approved at least 120 days for Doctoral Degree students / at least 60 days for Master's Degree students prior to the final oral examination.

3

Thesis Proposal Submission (Only students studying in thesis-oriented program)

Before the end of 6th semester for Doctoral Degree students and before the end of 4th semester for Master's Degree students.

2

Comprehensive/ Qualifying Examination

Doctoral Degree students in Plan 1 and Master's Degree students in Plan A1 must have passed the examination at least 120 days prior to the final oral examination.

1

English Language Examinations

Passed in the first semester.





Master's Degree

- ▶ Take the English proficiency tests with the university and receive a pass result **or**
- ▶ Enroll in the English required by Graduate School course (01355501) and receive a pass grade **or**
- ▶ Transfer an English proficiency test score in accordance with the specified criteria.

Doctoral Degree

Students are obligated to pass an English language examination in both oral and written tests to complete the doctoral program as follows:

- ▶ Take the written English examination with the university and receive a pass result **or**
- ▶ Enroll in the English required by Graduate School course (01355501), receive a pass grade, and pass the oral English examination **or**
- ▶ Transfer an English proficiency test score in accordance with the specified criteria.

Qualifying Examination

Doctoral Degree Students and Master's Degree Students in Plan A (A1)

Doctoral degree students in plan 1 and master's degree students in plan A (A1) are required to take the qualifying examination upon completion of 1 semester of the program registration.

Doctoral degree students in plan 2 are required to take the qualifying examination upon completion of not less than 2/3 of the graduate subjects specified in the course structure **(exclusive of the thesis credits)**.

The examination is conducted in both written and oral.

Warning:

For doctoral degree students in plan 1 and master's degree students in plan A (A1), the examination must be completed not less than 120 days prior to the final oral examination.

Comprehensive Examination

Master's Degree Students in Plan 1 (A2) and Plan 2

Take a comprehensive examination upon completion of at least 3/4 of the graduate subjects specified in the course structure **(exclusive of the thesis credits)**.

Warning:

- Students in Plan 1 (A2) might have passed the qualifying examination prior to the final oral examination.
- Students in Plan 2 must have passed the qualifying examination prior to the final oral examination.

The thesis proposal must be approved by the Dean of The Graduate School prior to taking the final oral examination.

- Master's Degree ≥ 60 days
- Doctoral Degree ≥ 120 days

Remark: Failure to comply results in the termination of student status.

GPA:

- GPA of graduate subjects ≥ 3.00
- GPA of undergraduate subjects (if any) ≥ 2.50

English Language Examinations:

- Passed English language examination as required by the Graduate School or English proficiency requirements.

Thesis Proposal:

- Doctoral Degree : approved **prior to the final oral examination ≥ 120 days**
- Master's Degree : (plan 1) approved **prior to the final oral examination ≥ 60 days**

Study Completion Form:

- Students have completed all coursework requirements and complied with Academic Regulations of Graduate Studies, Kasetsart University.

Qualifying Examination:

- Doctoral Degree students in plan 1 and Master's Degree students in plan 1 (A1) must have passed qualifying examination **prior to** taking the final oral examination ≥ 120 days.

Qualifying/Comprehensive Examination Results:

- Doctoral degree students --> Passed qualifying examination
- Master's degree students in plan 1 (A1) --> Passed qualifying examination
- Master's degree students in plan 1 (A2) --> Passed comprehensive examination
- Master's degree students in plan 2 --> Passed comprehensive examination

Request for Final Oral Examination:

- Submit the application for Final Oral Examination form to the Graduate School at least 15 days before the examination date.



Publication Requirements

Doctoral Degree

Plan 1

- At least 2 publications in acceptable international journals
or
- At least 1 publication accepted in the international journal and have at least 1 innovative or creative work, or have obtained at least 1 patent.

Students in social sciences and humanities may disseminate their theses in recognized national journals.

Plan 2

Theses or parts thereof that have been published in an international journal, or have obtained a patent, signify innovative or creative work.

Students in social sciences and humanities may disseminate their theses in recognized national journals.

Master's Degree

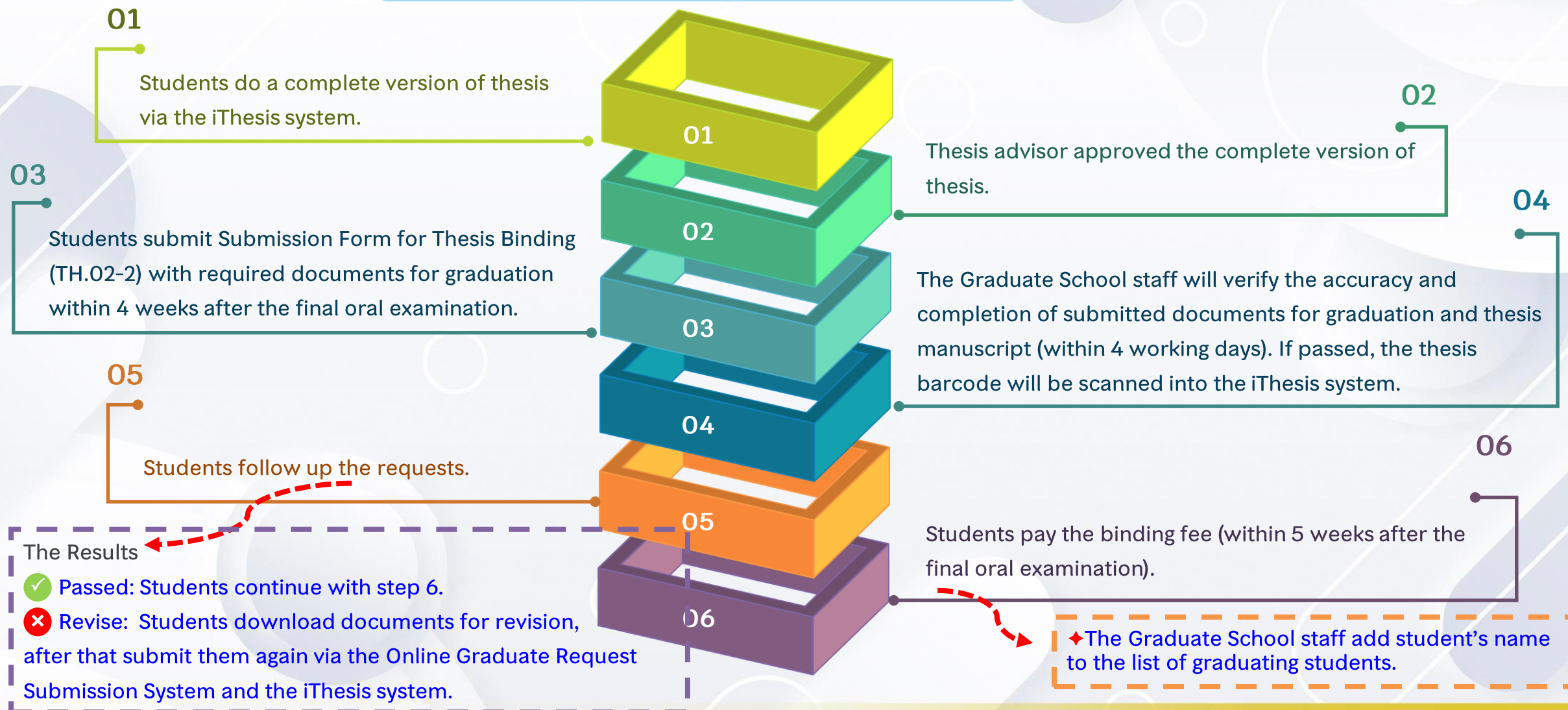
Plan 1 and 2

Theses / Independent studies or parts thereof are published or at least disseminated as article, innovation, invention, or other academic works in retrieval formats as determined by the University Council.

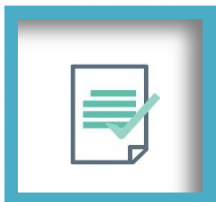

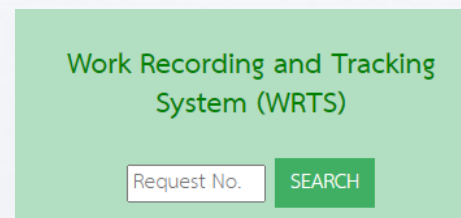
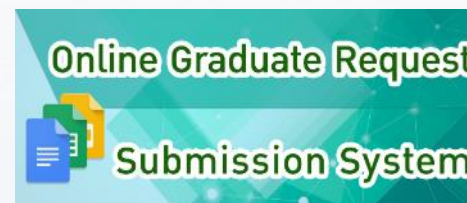
