The Okazaki Kaheita International Scholarship Foundation was established in March 1990 to contribute to world peace and development by fostering people from the People's Republic of China and other countries in Asia. In order to promote friendship between Japan and Asian countries and to further the personal development of people in these countries, the foundation provides scholarships to students from Asian countries who wish to study in graduate schools in Japan.

Applicant and Fields of Study:

The applicant shall be qualified to purse a course of study and research, with Japanese as the medium of instruction, in a master's course at a Japanese university. The applicant shall be free to choose his/her own field of study, excluding medicine, dentistry and veterinary science.

Number of Scholarships: 1 or 2

How to Apply:

Eligible students must be selected and recommend by their faculties. After that, please submit following required documents to the Dean of The Graduate School.

- 1) Student's recommendation letter from the Dean of his/her faculty
- 2) Student's transcript and academic performance records
- 3) Student's Scholarship Application Form
- 4) Student's Medical Examination Form
- 5) Student's recommendation from supervising professor stating the academic performance, personality and future prospects of the applicant, or Recommendation from employer at place of employment
