Subject: Exemption from English Studies for Master's Degree Students

With regard to the Announcement of The Graduate School, Kasetsart University on "Exemption from English Studies for Master's Degree Students" dated March 4, 2014, which stated that:

"The Graduate School provides an exemption from English studies which are required by The Graduate School for graduate students who graduated from institutes/universities in countries where the official language is English and which are approved by the Office of the Civil Service Commission (OCSC), or who graduated from international/English programs at institutes/universities which are approved by the OCSC."

In order to ensure that the guidelines for implementation of the exemption from English studies for master's degree students are put into practice correctly, the Committee of The Graduate School, at the 4/2014 Meeting on April 24, 2014, resolved to amend the guidelines by adding the following:

"The Graduate School provides an exemption from English studies which are required by The Graduate School for graduate students who graduated from institutes/universities in countries where the official language is English and which are approved by the Office of the Civil Service Commission (OCSC), or who graduated from international/English programs at institutes/universities which are approved by the OCSC. **Graduation from English speaking countries or international/English programs must not have taken place longer ago than 5 years, counted from the date of graduation.**"
