Guidelines for Writing a Concept Paper on Research Topic

Most research projects begin with concept papers. A concept paper is a document summarizing the concept of the research works. It shall explain the background and the importance of the research work, identify the research problems as well as research methodology. This document is very importance for the subsequence research works.

This “guideline for writing a concept paper” intents to provide rough idea for writing a concept paper. Applicant could adjust the topics and sequencings to suit their specific research works. The concept paper on research topics shall consist of the followings;

1. **Research Topic** Shall be concise, represent the research work which shall be in the field of Building Innovation
2. **Name and surname of the applicants**
3. **Introduction/Background** Describe the significant of the research work as well as identify the research problem.
4. **Research problems and objectives** Described research activities and the expected outcome. Research problems and objective shall correspond with research topics and research methodology.



5. **Research Methodology** Identify the research methodology that is correspondent with research problems and research objectives which might consist of
 - Related theories from literature reviews, select only main theories and ideas for the research work.
 - Research methodologies and research steps used.
 - Required information for the research work which would indicate the methodology to acquire the information needed and the analysis method.
 - Provide links among research information acquired, problem analysis method and the research objectives.
6. **Readiness for graduate study** Describe time available and supports for study and research works if applicable.
7. **Expected benefits** at the end of the research project
8. **Relationship between the research works with other aspects (optional)** i.e. investment feasibility, social impacts.
9. **References**

The Concept Paper on Research Topic shall have 3-5 pages (A4 not including references part). Proper language for easy understanding shall be used.
