Applicants must provide evidence of the English language ability

TOEFL: Paper-based total score not less than 550 with
Section 2 (Structure and Written Expression) and
Section 3 (Reading Comprehension) not less than 45 each

Internet-based total score not less than 50 with Reading Section Score not less than 15
and Writing Section Score not less than 17

Computer-based total score not less than 213

IELTS: score not less than 5.5

TOEIC: score not less than 650

* For applicants who do not have TOEFL / IELTS / TOEIC scores or graduated non - English or non - international bachelor's degree program must pass preliminary English test. **(KIMBA will arrange the English test before the interview.)**
