The Board of The Graduate School, in the meeting number 16/2021 on 9 December 2021, resolved to give a definition of the term "Excellent Academic Performance" which means that students must obtain a cumulative grade point average of not less than 3.25.

If a cumulative grade point average is less than 3.25 but more than 3.00, applicants may be considered for admission by examining applicants' sufficient knowledge, ability and potential to conduct and publish doctoral research which must be approved by the Admission Committee for Graduate Studies, Head of Department or Graduate Program Committee Chairperson, and Dean of the applied program, and then submit to the Graduate School for consideration. This is to be applied as a practice guideline of Kasetsart University from the first semester of 2022 academic year onwards.



Note:

- 1) Applicants must provide a statement of purpose to enroll in the program (1 page of A4-size paper), submitted together with the application.
- 2) Applicants must specify a list of 3 prospective thesis advisors in order of interest, (1 page of A4-size paper), submitted together with the application.
- 3) Applicants must provide at least 1 letter of recommendation from an academic advisor from a previous Bachelor's or Master's degree or a direct supervisor from the current job.
