The Board of The Graduate School, in the meeting number 16/2021 on 9 December 2021, resolved to give a definition of the term "Excellent Academic Performance" which means that students must obtain a cumulative grade point average of not less than 3.25.

If a cumulative grade point average is less than 3.25 but more than 3.00, applicants may be considered for admission by examining applicants' sufficient knowledge, ability and potential to conduct and publish doctoral research which must be approved by the Admission Committee for Graduate Studies, Head of Department or Graduate Program Committee Chairperson, and Dean of the applied program, and then submit to the Graduate School for consideration. This is to be applied as a practice guideline of Kasetsart University from the first semester of 2022 academic year onwards.
